At the beginning of 2021, it was already possible to use Connected Fueling to make mobile payments at the pump at over 700 gas stations in Germany. In addition to Germany, drivers can make mobile payments at the pump in Austria, Italy, Belgium, Luxembourg, Spain, Hungary, and the Netherlands. In the future, all 60,000 service stations in the DKV network are to become Connected Fueling-capable.
