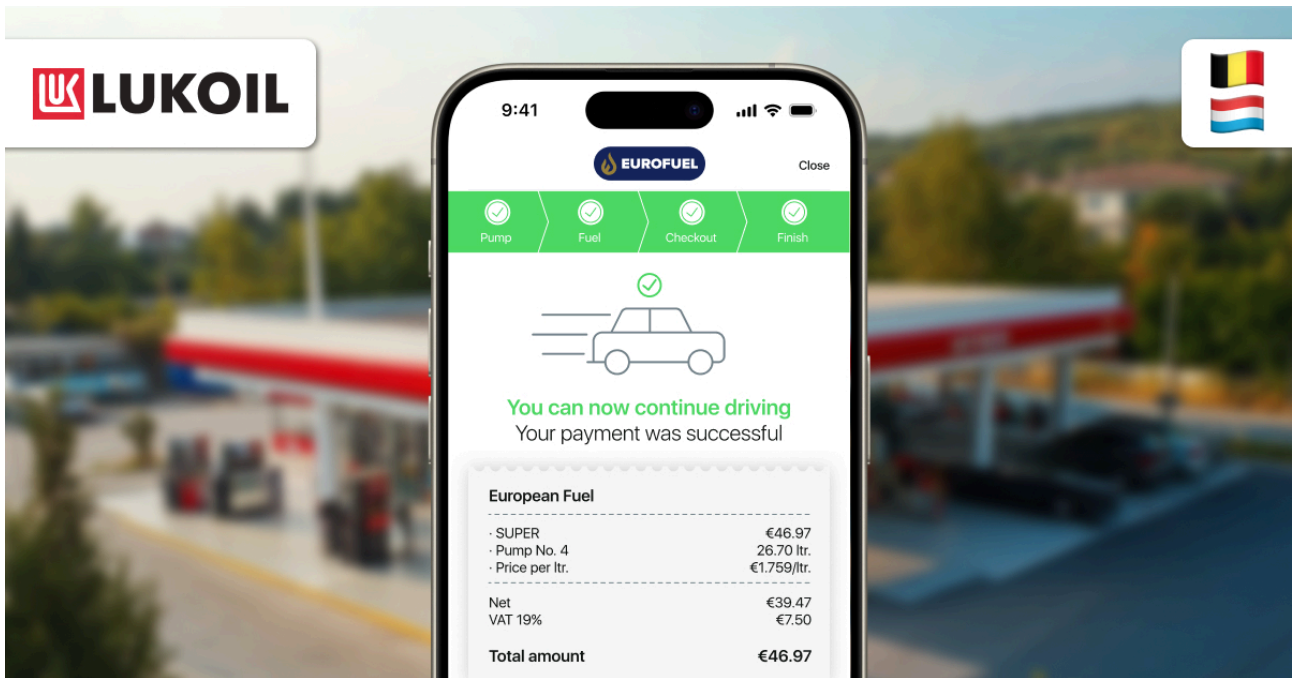


PACE Telematics integrates 181 Lukoil stations in Belgium and Luxembourg into its network
